

# My Christian PASSPORT out of this world of failure into His Kingdom of victory.

1. **I am a winner — 2 Cor 2:14** Now thanks *be* to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
2. **I am an adequate person — 2 Cor 3:4-6** <sup>4</sup>And we have such trust through Christ toward God. <sup>5</sup>Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as *being* from ourselves, but our sufficiency *is* from God, <sup>6</sup>who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.
3. **I am unique and special — 1 Pet 2:9** But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvellous light.
4. **My life has purpose — Eph 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
5. **As a person, I'm successful — Ps 1:1-3** <sup>1</sup>Blessed *is* the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; <sup>2</sup>But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. <sup>3</sup>He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.
6. **I am strong and able — Ps 27:1 (KJV)** The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
7. **I am sufficient for every task — Phil 4:13 (Amp)** I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency].
8. **I overcome every obstacle — John 16:33** These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."
9. **Reversals will not subdue me — 1 John 4:4** You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
10. **Designs to harm me shall fail — Isa 54:17** No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue *which* rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness *is* from Me," Says the LORD.
11. **I am secure and confident — Prov 3:24-26** <sup>24</sup>When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet. <sup>25</sup>Do not be afraid of sudden terror, nor of trouble from the wicked when it comes; <sup>26</sup>For the LORD will be your confidence, And will keep your foot from being caught.
12. **Under trial, I will stand — 1 Cor 10:13** No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.

13. **My works shall prosper — 1 Kings 2:2-3** <sup>2</sup>“I go the way of all the earth; be strong, therefore, and prove yourself a man. <sup>3</sup>And keep the charge of the LORD your God: to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments, His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn.
14. **I am well supplied — Ps 34:9-10** <sup>9</sup>Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! *There is no want to those who fear Him.* <sup>10</sup>The young lions lack and suffer hunger; But those who seek the LORD shall not lack any good *thing*.
15. **Health and prosperity are mine — 3 John 2** Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.
16. **My needs are always met — Phil 4:19** And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
17. **I am well and healthy — Matt 8:16-17** <sup>16</sup>When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, <sup>17</sup>that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses.”
18. **My thoughts are affirmative — Phil 4:6-9** <sup>6</sup>Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; <sup>7</sup>and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. <sup>8</sup>Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. <sup>9</sup>The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.
19. **My worries are over — 1 Pet 5:7 (Amp)** Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately *and* cares about you watchfully.
20. **Fear is not my practice — 2 Tim 1:7 (KJV)** For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
21. **I am a totally new person — 2 Cor 5:17** Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
22. **I am happy, happy, happy — Phil 4:4** Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!
23. **I am free, I'm free — John 8:32** And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
24. **All this is true and I believe it — Num 23:19-20** <sup>19</sup>“God *is* not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good? <sup>20</sup>Behold, I have received *a command* to bless; He has blessed, and I cannot reverse it.
25. **I envision each affirmation — 1 Chron 29:18 (KJV)** O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto Thee.
