SERMON TITLE: DON'T PROCEED WITHOUT GOD'S PEACE

FOUNDATION SCRIPTURE: Colossians 3 v 15 (Amp) Let the peace of Christ [the inner calm of one who walks daily with Him] be the controlling factor in your hearts [deciding and settling questions that arise]. To this peace indeed you were called as members in one body [of believers]. And be thankful [to God always].

When your thoughts, plans and actions are approved by God, He'll confirm it by giving you an inner knowing (peace).

1 John 2 v 20; Prov 3 v 32; Amos 3 v 7; Job 32 v 8

1 Cor 2 v 14 - God always leads me in triumph...

1 Cor 2 v 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world...

When we are being led by God, we will have a sense of peace, even in the midst of difficult circumstances. John 16 v 13

God is always a step ahead.

Isa 65 v 24. Often in a crisis, there is no time to call the Pastor or your Prayer Partner, that's when it's good to know, God said before they call... I will answer.

His faithful promises are your armour and protection.

Ps 91 v 4,11 & 14 (NLT)

No plague will come near your home. Ps 91 v 10; James 3 v 17-18

Let the Holy Spirit change your way of thinking. Eph 4:29 While effort has nothing to do with your Salvation it has much to do with your Spiritual Growth.

Don't just sit and wait for something to happen.

Eph 4 v 22 - 24 The Bible says:

1. Verse 22: Choose to let go of old ways, things, old stories. Everything must go. Throw off (NLT)
2. Verse 23: Change the way you think. Romans 12 v 1- 2. We are changed from the inside out.
3. Verse 24: Put on your New Nature by developing (on purpose) new habits, thoughts, actions and plans.

Remember: Don't just sit and wait for Spiritual Growth to happen. Be obedient and unlock the power of God in your life.

Don't proceed without God's peace.
