Scripture: Hebrews 10 v 23 - 25

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, 25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Programmes versus paradigms (Examples).

It is obvious that the leadership of the early Church placed a lot of emphasis on godly examples and on relationship rather than on maturing believers through programmes.

Paul writing to Timothy said in 1 Timothy 4 v 12: Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit in faith, in purity.

1 Peter 5 v 3 (NIV) - Not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.

What profit is there if you gain the whole world -- and lose eternal life? What can be compared with the value of eternal life? (TLB)

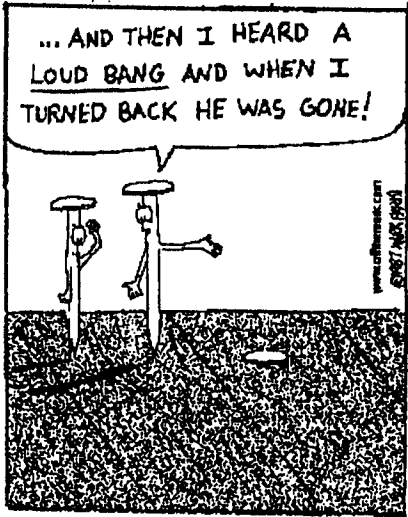
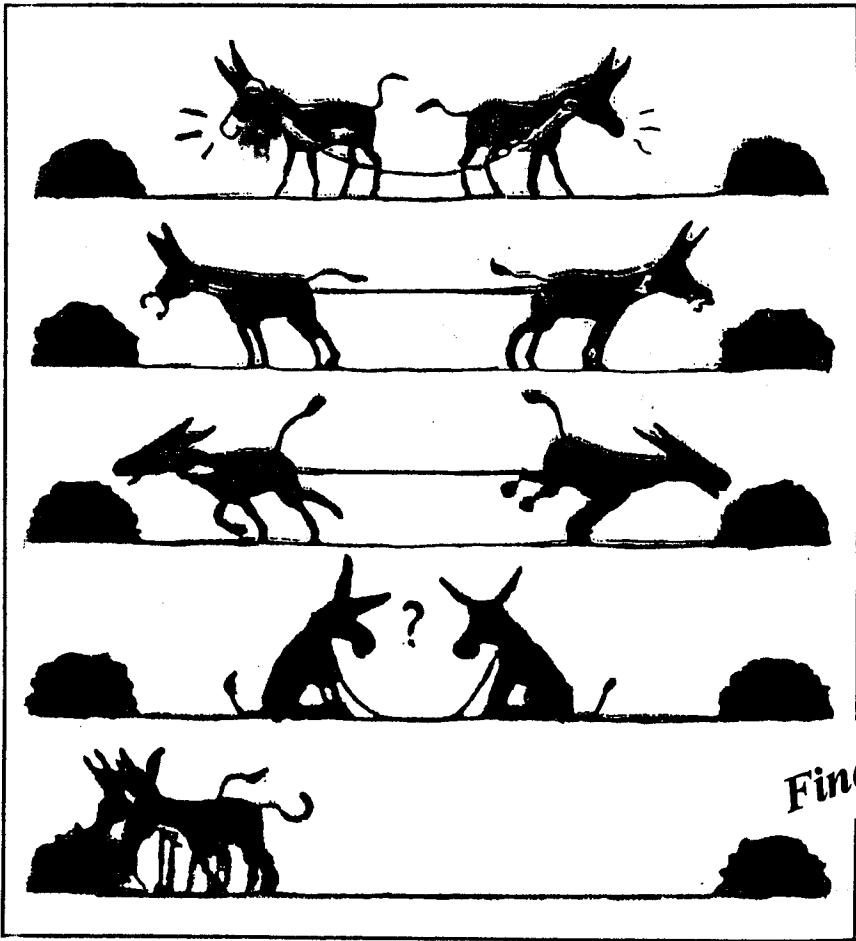
