Sermon Title: HOW GOD FULFILLS HIS PROMISES

Scripture: Isaiah 55 v 11

So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.



God fulfils some promises...

In Predictable, Expected Ways

Some promises we see, have already been fulfilled, clear and undeniable just as expected.

Exodus 8 - God told Pharaoh that He would send a plague of frogs (He did). When God told David that his son, Solomon, would build the Temple, he did. When God said that Judah would be judged for being unfaithful (Jer 25). Jesus said that the Temple would be destroyed - that not one brick shall be left on another (70 AD it was demolished).

Sometime in ways we could never imagine...

In Unexpected, Supernatural Ways

Exodus 14 - God parted the Red Sea-defeated Pharaoh's army.

Joshua 6 - God collapsed the walls of Jericho. 2 Kings 17 v 35 - An Angel of the Lord slew 185 000 Syrian soldiers in one night.

On many occasions Apostle Paul used the word mystery to describe how God's plan of Salvation is fulfilled in Christ.

While we try to figure out how God is going to do it - HE calmly fulfills it - Isaiah 55 v 8 - 9.

God Fulfills His Promises through Spiritual Blessings

The Psalms contain statements of the Power of God to bless the righteous with protection, wealth, health and long life. We would be wrong if we expect nothing more than just physical blessings in this life. God is faithful by providing spiritual blessings.

Ephesians 1 v 3

God fulfills His promises - in His time.
