Sermon Title: THERE IS A RIVER



John 7:37-38

On the last day that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

Central Truth: Don't settle for an average life with God.

As Christians you will never know what you, with God, can do together until you get to a higher place, until you fight for a **deeper** relationship, until you reach for **higher** goals, until you **press in** for the one prize... you will never know.

We can spend fruitless hours in prayer if our hearts are not prepared beforehand: Proverbs 4 v 20-24.

Romans 10 v 17 Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God (See Joshua 1 v 8) Day and night.

Remember your purpose (Philippians 3 v 8-14; Proverbs 10 v 4).

Get in the River - Be filled with the Holy Spirit - Ephesians 5 v 18

- A) Faithfulness - Obey the Word.
- B) Overcome the flesh - 1 Corinthians 9 v 27 The Holy Spirit our Helper.
- C) Stir up your (Gift) Call, Purpose - 1 Timothy 4 v 12
